



## Vermont Creative Schools Initiative Teacher Institute

June 24-28 in Montpelier

2019 Essential Question:

### *The Earth is speaking—how do we respond?*

- Learn with **national leaders** in the fields of project-based learning, curriculum integration and creativity.
- Design your school project for the **Youth Environment Summit** (YES) on November 1st, presented by the UVM Extension 4-H Program.
- Receive a **seven-day teaching artist residency** to support your YES project.
- Earn three **graduate credits**.

All teacher teams (three or more) will **partner with an experienced teaching artist** at the Institute for five days of planning and learning to build a project plan for the Youth Environment Summit that uses this essential question as a springboard: *The Earth is speaking — how do we respond?*

**We fund a teaching artist to work with your team for a seven-day in-school residency in the fall to support your project implementation.**

The Institute is an **incubator for your YES project** where you shape your project, design curriculum connections, and integrate a creative component that deepens student engagement and leverages a creative spotlight to lift it the project to the next level.

**Tuition:** \$1,990 for three credits. \$1,650 for Certificate of Participation. Includes lunches at the Institute, and the cost of the seven-day teaching artist residency in your school. Lodging in Montpelier available upon request.
