To best make use of the workshop, it is important your family comes prepared with the **checklist of materials below**. If you do not bring the requested materials, we may not be able to work on your student's CSS Profile Form while you are here.

Checklist: Things you need to bring/have access to for CSS Profile Forms Night:

- Access to your student's College Board account**
- The purchase year, purchase price, current value and current debt of the home that you live in
- Student's Social Security Number (SSN) and date of birth (or Alien Registration Number, if applicable)
- Student Driver's License Number
- Parent(s) Social Security Number and date of birth, month, and year of marriage or separation/divorce (or Alien Registration Number, if applicable)
- Federal Tax Returns 2023 and W-2 Forms, for BOTH student and parent(s) from the previous year (if already received or completed)
- Information for BOTH Student and Parent(s)
 - Savings & checking account balances
 - CD's, stocks, bonds, mutual funds, and money market accounts
 - Savings bonds
 - 529 Plans for all children in the family
 - Trust Funds, UTMA or UGMA
 - Value of any second property, home, camp, cottage condo or timeshare owned
- List of all colleges the student is applying to
- Records of any Veterans Benefits for both parent(s) and student
